### **Philosophy:**

Raptors HC aims provide an environment that will encourage our Coaches and Team Managers to act with autonomy to nurture and develop guidelines that will cater to the needs of the players specifically on their team.

Raptors HC will work with Player Development and Player Advancement as our primary goal and guiding principle. # PHILOSOPHY OF RAPTORS SQ B

### Why Squirt B ? Who does this program serve ? :

Raptors Squirt B players come from families that have **Training & Development** as the priority for the hockey player in their family.

Raptors HC recognizes that all players are not ready to make a "full dive" into Travel Hockey – not just from a physical level on the ice, but from a lifestyle commitment off of the ice as well.

The Raptors Squirt B team will be the perfect landing place for families with 2009 and 2010 birth year players that wish prioritize development, while simultaneously playing and competing at the appropriate level for the current level of the players. The time and financial commitment of this program will allow for a smooth transition for families that may be looking for a more intense travel hockey experience in the future.

# HOME ICE

- The Raptors Hockey Club will *contract* its ice slots for Home Games:
  - Saturday's for 1 game. Every Saturday home game in 2018-19 was 2:45pm @ Factory Wake Forest per contracted ice.
  - **Sunday's for 1 game.** Virtually every Sunday home game in 2018-19 was 9:55am @ RCI per contracted ice.
- Allotted Ice Time for Games : 90 min
- Number of Home weekends : 5
  - Will include 2 weekends of home practice.



### GAMES

#### The team will play an independent schedule consisting of:

- 12 Games = "Home & Home" matchups Vs. 3 Teams\*
- 8 Games = 2 Tournaments (potential for extra games)
- 2 Games = Exhibition Games
- \* They team may play in the CHL, resulting in the Home & Home matchups potentially being replaced by the CHL Round Robin schedules.

#### **Total Games: 22, of which 12 will be home games.**

# **ICE TIME & DEVELOPMENT**

### **On Ice Practice:**

• 8 sessions of shared practice with another Raptors team.

### **Weekend On Ice Practice:**

• 2 Scheduled Home weekends of Team Practice (4 sessions, 90 min per session)

### **On Ice Development:**

- 1.25 Hours Weekly @ Factory Wake Forest in Prime Time Hockey's YDP Session. (Mondays)
- 1 Hour Weekly @ Factory Wake Forest in Prime Time Hockey's YDP Session. (Thursdays)

### **Total On Ice for Team Practice & Development : 76 Hours!**



# **EXTRA TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT**

#### The team will take full advantage of the Prime Time Hockey training facility in 2 ways:

- 10 90-min Training sessions for an additional 15 hours of training & development
- 1 weekly 30min shooting sessions in small groups (team will be divided into small groups, with one of the groups attending the session each week)\*

\*small group shooting sessions can be scheduled on days that the team is already at Factory.





### **SPECIALIZED EXTRA TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT**

#### ALL Raptors Squirt B players will receive 1 complimentary semi-private lesson from Prime Time Hockey:

- Sessions will take place during the Stick/Puck ice times offered at Factory Ice House
- Sessions will be 60 minutes in length

\*Families will be required to cover the cost for Stick/Puck Registration





# THE DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

Part of the Development Process for the Raptors Squirt Team will be to have an open line of communication with players and parents thru Individual Evaluations.

The coaching staff will conduct individual player evaluations in 3 phases during the hockey season:

- 1) Post Training Camp Evaluation.
- 2) Mid-Season Evaluation.
- 3) Final Evaluation at Season's End.

# **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

In addition to developing our players on the ice, Raptors HC will aim to have our players help develop and improve parts of our local community.

It will be a goal to have our entire Squirt B team participate together in a minimum of 3 hours of Community Service.

#### All for a Registration Fee of \$2,495

\*Equipment & Apparel package will be between \$425-\$460. An 'A La Cart" menu will be made available for returning Raptors that don't require entire package.



# **Payment Options**

There will be 4 options available for payment of registration fees. All payments made by credit card will be subject to an additional 3% fee.


