Serving as USA Hockey's local Director of Goaltending Development for the past 8 years, Brian brings a vast hockey background to the Raptors Hockey Club.





Coach Brian's Background

Brian grew up in Minot, North Dakota playing youth hockey. He played 2 years of juniors in the United States Hockey League (USHL). He graduated from the University of Nebraska at Omaha with a Bachelors of Science in education with a coaching endorsement. He played 4 years of NCAA D1 hockey for the Mavericks. After graduation, he played 1 season as a professional goalie in the United Hockey League.

Brian moved to NC in 2004 to pursue a career in NASCAR. He spent 8.5 years as a tire changer and has been a pit crew coach for 20 years. He is currently the head coach at Joe Gibbs Racing, overseeing 8 pit crews. During the past 20 years, Brian has been fortunate to be a part of 5 NASCAR cup championships.

He started training goalies in Charlotte in 2008 and started Old School Goal School in 2011. Brian has worked with hundreds of goalies over the years. He was an assistant coach and goalie coach for the Charlotte Rush USPHL junior team for 5 years winning 3 National Championships with them. In 2016, he became the Goalie Development Coordinator for USA Hockey for North and South Carolina.

For the past 3 years, Brian has been coaching youth hockey. He is passionate about coaching and his love for kids and growing their love of hockey is always evident on the ice. He's looking forward to being a Raptor and having a great season!



HOME ICE

- The Raptors Hockey Club will once again contract its ice slots for consistency of home game times:
 - Saturday's for 4 games. Saturday home games during the 2022-23 season were 3:15pm & 4:45pm, 6:15pm & 7:45pm @ Factory Wake Forest, per contracted ice.
 - **Sunday's for 4 games.** Most Sunday home games during the 2022-23 season were 6:45am, 8:15am, 9:45am & 11:15am @ Factory Wake Forest, per contracted ice.
- Allotted Ice Time for Games: 75 & 90 min
- Minimum number of Home weekends: 6
 - Potential for adding a 7th home weekend as practice or games.

Pre-Season Team Training Camp:

• 6 Hours On Ice (3 days over full weekend in mid or late August)

On Team Ice Practice:

- 1 Hour Weekly (traditionally @ Factory Wake Forest, but could potentially be rotated)*
- 2022-23 Time Slot: Friday 5:00pm-6:00pm @ Raleigh IcePlex.
- 2023-24 Time Slot: Likely to be 6:15pm-7:15pm @ Raleigh IcePlex.

On Ice Development:

- 1 Hour Weekly, 2022-23 was Mon 6:15pm @ Factory Wake Forest (Skating/Agility/Puck)
- 1 Hour Weekly, 2022-23 was Thurs 6:00pm @ Factory Wake Forest (Shooting & Scoring)

EXTRA TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

The team will take full advantage of the Prime Time Hockey training facility in 2 ways:

- 8 90-min Team Training sessions for an additional 12 hours of training & development
- 1 bi-weekly 30min team shooting session in small groups following the teams on ice sessions that are at The Factory.*

*small group shooting sessions can be scheduled on any of the on-ice days the team prefers. The sessions will be a rotation of different players each week.





SPECIALIZED EXTRA TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

ALL Raptors Squirt AA players will receive a complimentary semi-private session from Prime Time Hockey:

- Sessions will take place during the "Stick/Puck" or "Hockey Camp" ice times offered at Factory Ice House
- Sessions will be 60 minutes in length

 *Families will be required to cover the cost for Stick/Puck
 or Hockey Camp Registration.





THE DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

Part of the Development Process for the Raptors Squirt AA Team will be to have an open line of communication with players and parents thru Individual Evaluations.

The coaching staff will conduct individual player evaluations 3 times during the hockey season:

- 1) Post Training Camp Evaluation. (Written & In Person)
- 2) Mid-Season Evaluation. (Written)
- 3) Final Evaluation at Season's End. (Written & In Person)

COMMUNITY SERVICE

In addition to developing our players on the ice, Raptors HC aims to have our players help to develop and improve parts of our local community.

It will be a goal to have our entire Squirt AA team to participate together in a minimum of 3 hours of Community Service.



During the Club's first 5 seasons, Raptors teams have created and delivered large care packages for U.S. Troops stationed overseas, filled Xmas Stockings for both a senior citizens home and kids that were impacted by Hurricane Florence, organized a food drives, and cleaned a local Creek. The Club has also participated in the JDRF One Walk for Type 1 Diabetes awareness and fundraising.
