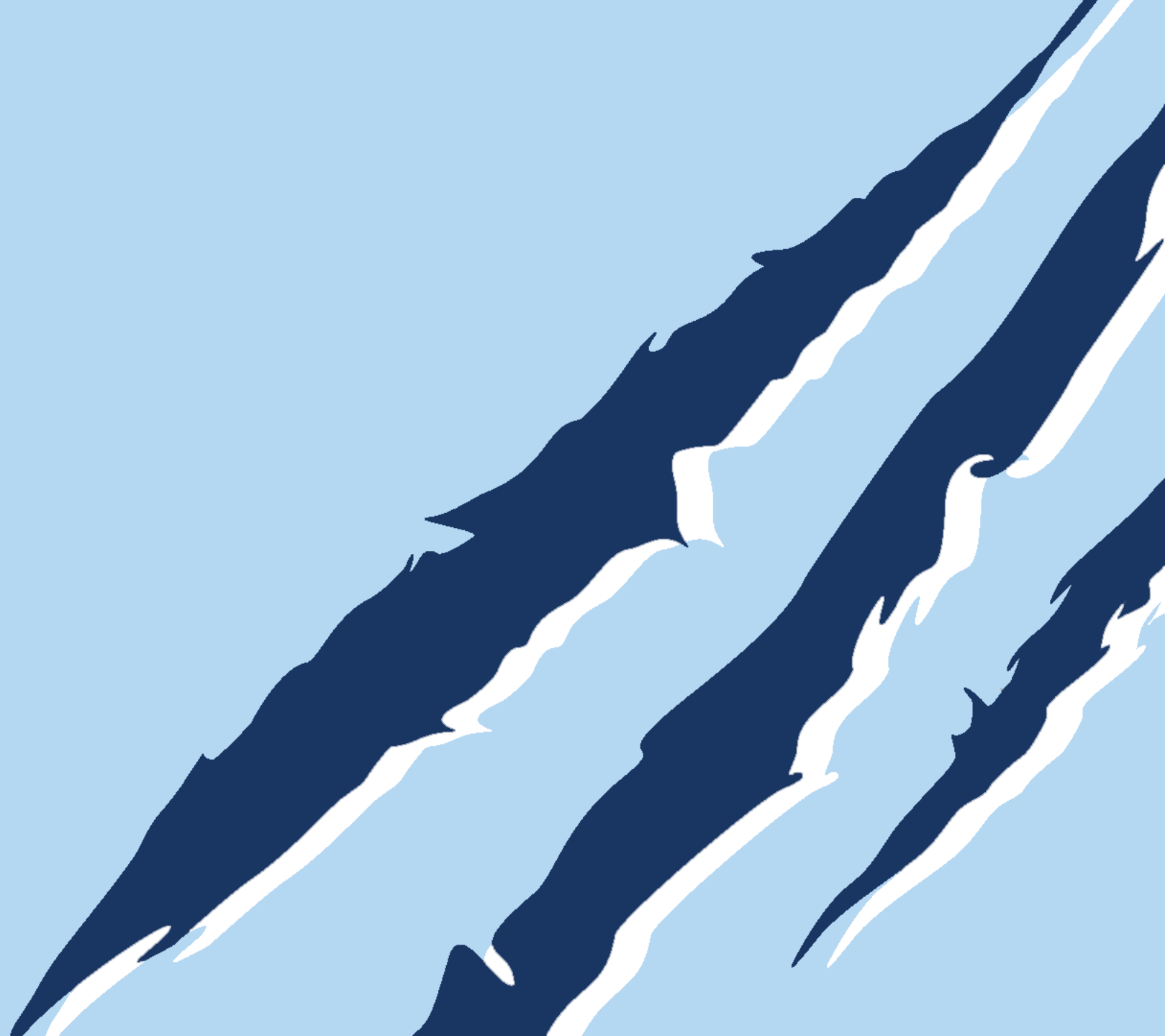


PROGRAM OVERVIEW

APPAREL PACKAGE

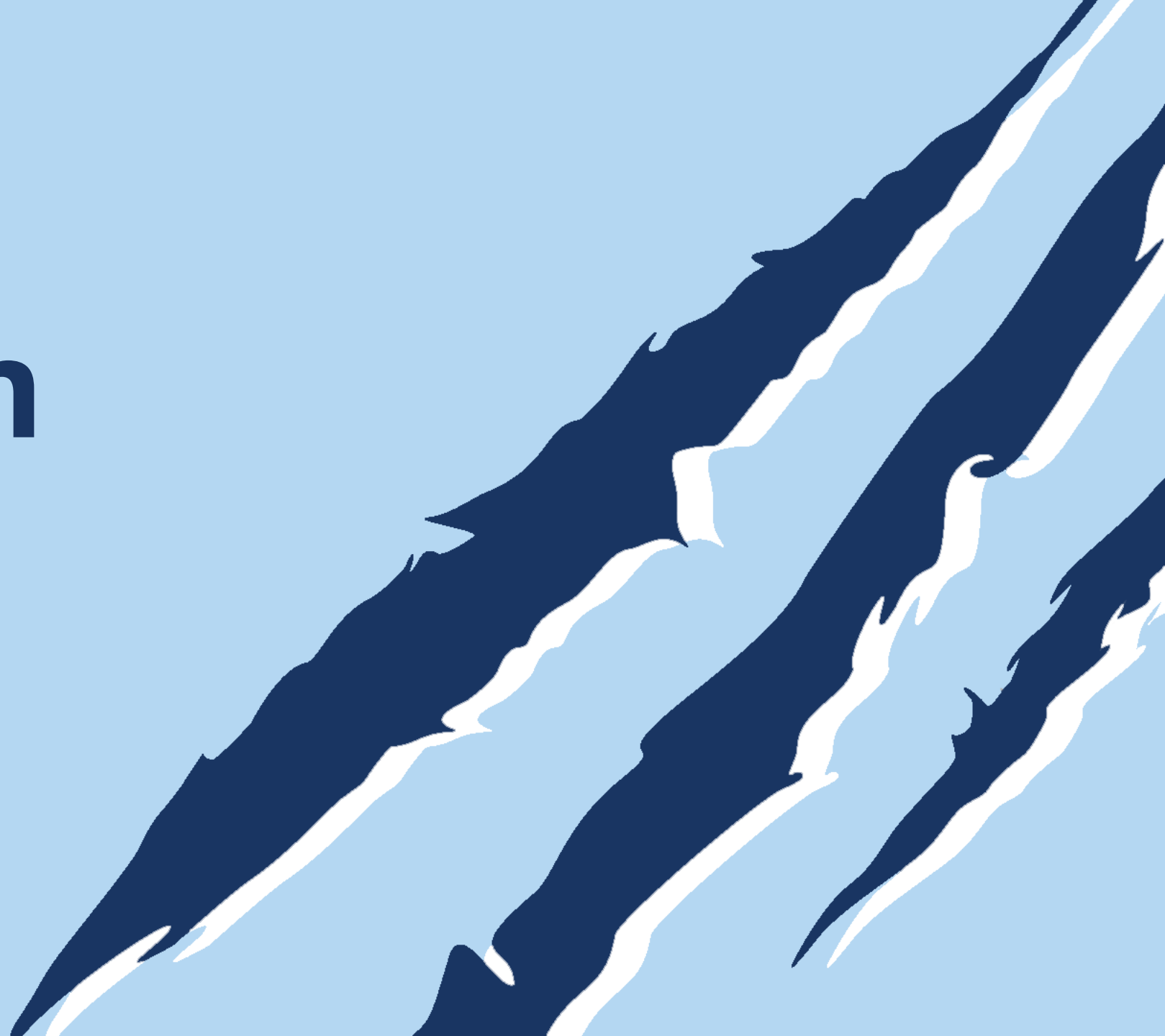
- Travel is not included nor is hockey equipment, parent sponsored events and team required apparel.
