Raptors HC will continue to prioritize providing hockey families with more ice time, more programming, and more accountability for lower registration fees than the other local hockey groups.

2024-2025

Of the 8 Raptors teams that played in the 2nd season of the ACHC - 2 teams walked away with Championships, while 4 others finished as the runner up finalists.

2023-2024

For the Inaugural season of the ACHC, the Raptors had teams participate in each of the 2 divisions that the new Conference launched. No Championships, but 1 of our 2 teams gave themselves a chance by reaching the Finals.



2024-2025

WON the Silver Stick Regional Championship to advance to International Finals and finished 6th place overall.

2023-2024

WON the Silver Stick Regional Championship to advance to International Finals and finished 9th place overall.



2024-2025

Raptors had 45.9% of the players selected to the final rosters – more than any other Club

2023-2024

Raptors had more players selected to the rosters than any other Club, making up 45.7% of the total players chosen at tryouts.

2022-2023

Raptors had 34.8% of the players selected to the final rosters – more than any other Club.



2024-2025

Of the 2 teams that the Raptors had in the CHL – both of them finished as the runner up finalists in their division.

2023-2024

Of the 6 teams that the Raptors had in the CHL - 3 of them WON the CHL Championship (50% winning rate)

2022-2023

Raptors had 10 teams play in the league – 5 of them WON the CHL Championship (50% winning rate), and 2 others finishing as runner up finalist.

HOME ICE

- The Raptors Hockey Club will once again contract its ice slots for consistency of home game times:
 - **Saturday's for 4 games.** Saturday home games during the 2024-25 season were 3:15pm & 4:45pm & 6:15pm & 7:45pm @ Factory Wake Forest, per contracted ice.
 - **Sunday's for 4 games.** Most Sunday home games during the 2024-25 season were 6:45am & 8:15am & 9:45am & 11:15am @ Factory Wake Forest, per contracted ice.
- Allotted Ice Time for Games : 75 & 90 min
- Minimum number of Home weekends : 6
 - Potential for adding a 7th home weekend as practice or games.



GAMES

The team will plan to play in either the ACHC or CHL, usually consisting of:

- 16 Games = "Home & Home" League matchups Vs. 4 Teams in Division
- 8 Games = "Home & Home" Independent Exhibition Games
- 16 Games = 4 Tournaments (potential for extra games)

Total Games: 40, of which 20-26 will be in Raleigh.

ICE TIME & DEVELOPMENT

Pre-Season Team Training Camp:

- 6 Hours On Ice (4 days @ 1.5hrs/daily, over course of a full weekend in August 2024)

On Team Ice Practice:

- 1 weekly practice, where Raptors Bantam A team will be the only team on the ice.
(traditionally @ Factory Wake Forest, but could potentially be rotated between Cary & IcePlex)
- 2024-25 Time Slot : Fridays 5:00pm & Raleigh IcePlex.

On Ice Development:

- 1 Hour Weekly, Advanced Skating/Agility/Puck Control with Prime Time Hockey school.
- 1 Hour Weekly, Advanced Shooting & Scoring with Prime Time Hockey school.

Total On Ice for Team Practice & Development : 82 Hours!



EXTRA TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

The team will take full advantage of the Prime Time Hockey training facility with:

- **8** (90-min) Training sessions for an additional 9 hours of training & development.
- **These sessions will be structured as:**
 - 30min Skating Treadmill Training
 - 60min Specialized Shooting Training
 - (potential to utilize 30min video review or 30 min off-ice fitness training)



SPECIALIZED EXTRA TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

ALL Raptors Bantam A players will receive 1 complimentary semi-private lesson from Prime Time Hockey:

- Sessions will take place during the ice times offered at Factory Ice House for small group private lessons.
- Sessions will be 60 minutes in length
 - *Families will be required to cover the cost for Stick/Puck Registration*



THE DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

Part of the Development Process for the Raptors Bantam A Team will be to have an open line of communication with players and parents thru Individual Evaluations.

The coaching staff will conduct individual player evaluations in 3 phases during the hockey season:

- 1) Post Training Camp Evaluation. (Written and in person)
- 2) Mid-Season Evaluation. (Written)
- 3) Final Evaluation at Season's End. (Written and in person)

In addition to developing our players on the ice, Raptors HC will aim to have our players help develop and improve parts of our local community.

It will be a goal to have our entire Bantam A team participate together in a minimum of 3 hours of Community Service.

During past seasons, our Raptors Bantam A's have cleaned the memorial stones along the 3rd Special Forces Group Memorial Walk at Fort Bragg, organized a Christmas Toy Drives, and filled backpacks with school supplies for students


